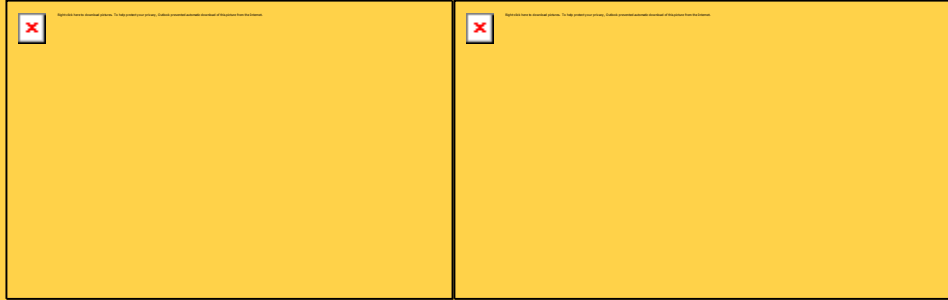
The fun isn't over yet!

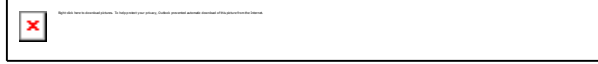


The ongoing Bike Repair Project
